The Advocacy Accelerator will create a register of consultants / experts (or technical assistance providers) in advocacy that will form part of a demand-driven responsive market and technical assistance needs. The Accelerator is also working to establish a technical assistance forum where providers and experts engage, share and learn from each other on functional aspects of the provision of technical assistance in advocacy.

Therefore, as a precursor to the establishment of the register, Amref and the Advocacy Accelerator invite experts providing technical assistance to demonstrate their interests. Pre-screened candidates will then be selected as part of a quality assurance process.
